





Special Rate of 25c via Local Sailing Ship

- Special service amongst Pointe-a-Pitre, Basse-Terre and Marie Galante via local sailing vessel
- Rate of 25c in lieu of the 20c local rate via surface transportation
- Applicable from February 1866 until January 1885
- Seldom seen and little recognized, but noted in Dubus book




Pointe-a-Pitre February 25, 1877 Local rate of 25c via sailing ship






